## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

We moved into our 2018 classes this week. Thank you to parents for your support in the transition to new classes. Classes have been very settled and are well into their learning program.

Kindergarten students also started their primary schooling on Monday. Welcome to our new families and welcome back to our continuing families.

Since November last year we have had 49 students arrive and 30 students move on. New families have arrived from all over including Queensland and Singapore. Welcome to all of our new families.

We now have 840 students organised into 35 classes.

### Parent Information Sessions

All stages will hold an information session to inform parents and carers of routines and procedures and also provide an overview of learning and ways parents and carers can support learning. If you are unable to attend, teachers will send home a letter with some key points.

Kindergarten will hold theirs next Tuesday (please note that the times are 6 – 7pm as they were incorrect on the note last week).

Years 1 – 6 will hold their sessions on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

### Arrival at School

School commences at 8.55am. To reduce traffic congestion we provide supervision from 8.30am to allow parents to drop students off to school over a 25 minute period.

No supervision is provided prior to 8.30am. Students **should not** be at school prior to 8.30am. Please ensure your child is not arriving at school prior to 8.30am.

If students happen to arrive prior to 8.30am they are to proceed to the seats outside the school office and sit and wait for the teacher to be on duty at 8.30am.

## School Uniform

Thank you parents and carers for your efforts to ensure your child is in correct uniform each day.

The school uniform was set by a vote of the school community several years ago. The agreed uniform is what students should be wearing to school.

Students have two choices:

School dress White socks Black shoes	Grey Shorts Blue school polo Grey socks Black shoes

- Sports uniform is worn on sports days.
- Blue shorts and blue polo ***is not*** part of the uniform. If students wish to wear shorts then they need to wear grey shorts with the blue school polo.
- Black socks, tights and shorts are not part of the uniform.
- Please ensure your child has their school hat each day.
- Please ensure hair ties, ribbons and bows are in school colours (blue or white).

If you feel there should be a change to the uniform then you need to write to the P & C who will consider the desire for change, explore options and put them back to the school community for a vote.

## Parents and Citizens Association (P&C)

We have a terrific P & C team who work tirelessly to support the school and our students.

The P & C meets twice a term on the Monday of Weeks 3 & 8. Meetings are held at 7pm in the school staffroom. Meetings finish by 9pm.

The P & C manages the uniform shop and the canteen. They have input into school directions and policy. They fundraise for a range of projects to improve the school.

All parents and carers are encouraged to attend and be part of the P & C. If you can't make the meetings there are lots of ways you can contribute by helping at P & C events, in the canteen or at the uniform shop.

The first meeting of the P & C will be held this Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February in the school staffroom (enter via the school office).

## ADMINISTRATION

Welcome back to all our families to a new school year. For the office it has been a busy start to the year.

### Notes Home

If you have misplaced a note simply hop onto our school's website. You will find notes sent home under the "Notes and Forms" tab.

### Payments

**Online payments are preferred.** To access the Parent Online Payments just go on to the school's website and click on the "\$ Make a Payment Link". This link will take you to a Westpac site where you can make payments directly to the school.

Westpac has been working on an upgrade to the Parent Online Payment webpage. In the past using the "\$ Make a Payment" page through a mobile device or tablet has not been as easy as on a computer. Now, automatically, when parents click on this page, via a mobile device, they will be able to complete the online form with ease.

Other forms of payment accepted are eftpos, cash and cheque.

### Canteen/Uniform/P&C Orders

The P&C and Canteen have their own bank account and are **separate** from the school. Please **do not** pay online via the school for meal deal orders or uniform orders. You need to use Flexischools for these orders. Any payments received through the school's online payment system will be refunded straight back onto your card.

### Scholastic Book Club Orders

All Scholastic Book Club orders need to be done online through Scholastic. The school doesn't accept payments anymore.

### Money Due

As you can see, we have already invoiced for book packs and swimming carnival. You are more than welcome to pay book packs off in instalments, this is especially helpful if you have more than one child in the school.

Did you know that ***you can make regular payments in advance?*** This might be helpful to you if you have a child/children in Stage 3 with Year 5 going to the Aussie Bush Camp this year and Year 6 to Canberra. Money will be receipted in 'Fees in Advance' and can then be put towards excursions, etc.

## **Special Religious Education (SRE) and Special Education in Ethics (SEE)**



***Special Religious Education (SRE) is education in the beliefs and practices of an approved religious persuasion. Special Education in Ethics (SEE) is a program in ethical decision making, action and reflection within a secular framework, based on a branch of philosophy.***

Scripture is undertaken by a group of volunteers who come into the school to provide students with a basic introduction to religion. These lessons often take the form of short moral stories and activities that provide valuable personal development for the children.

Ethics involve developing core skills such as listening to others, taking turns to speak and giving reasons. Stories, poems and rhymes prompt children to discuss ethical issues. Volunteers follow a curriculum that has been developed specifically to enhance children's thinking and reasoning skills.

Scripture and Ethics classes are conducted at Terrigal Public School each Tuesday.

- Kindergarten, Years 1, 2      11.30-12.00
- Years 3, 4, 5, 6.              12.00-12.30

Both Scripture and Ethics volunteers have Working with Children Checks and are from approved providers. Classroom teachers maintain their role as supervisors during Scripture and Ethics classes.

Students are placed into religious groups according to the information provided on your school enrolment form. In 2018, Terrigal Public school will have Catholic and Protestant approved religious education programs.

If you selected 'No religion' your child will be placed with a group of children away from religious classes and participate in meaningful activities such as reading and private study.

No academic instruction or formal school activities occur during the time set aside for SRE/SEE.

Those students enrolled in Non Scripture may be given the option to participate in Ethics classes. Expression of interest letters are sent home early in Term One. The availability of these classes depend on the number of trained Ethics teachers that our school has available.

If no selection was made on your enrolment form or your particular religious persuasion is not catered for at our school, parents will be given a chance to nominate which group they would like their child to attend.

Students continue in the same arrangement each year, unless a parent/caregiver has requested a change in writing. At any time, you have the right to change your SRE/SEE nomination or to withdraw your child from the nominated lessons. A note to the office will affect this change.

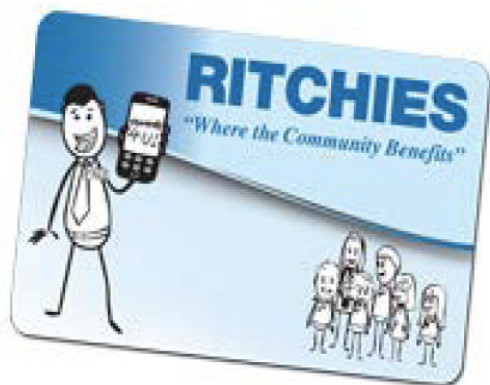

# BaRK Reading Program

BaRK is a free eight-week program to assist reluctant readers. Children practice reading aloud on a one-to-one basis to a trained therapy dog from the Delta Society.

## Dogs are great listeners!

When reading to a dog, children enjoy an environment of unconditional acceptance and emotional support. Our animal assisted reading program removes stress and peer pressure for the reluctant reader. BaRK makes reading fun.

## How does BaRK encourage reluctant readers to read?

A bond is encouraged between child and dog by having the same child read to the same dog each week. The dog allows children to gain confidence and self esteem by providing his/her love and attention in an atmosphere free of criticism.

## What type of students will benefit from BaRK?

The BaRK program is beneficial to all children struggling with their reading. This confidence building program also benefits children who lack self esteem or who are shy. Any primary aged children experiencing difficulty in reading may be nominated for the program by a teacher or parent.

## How does it work?

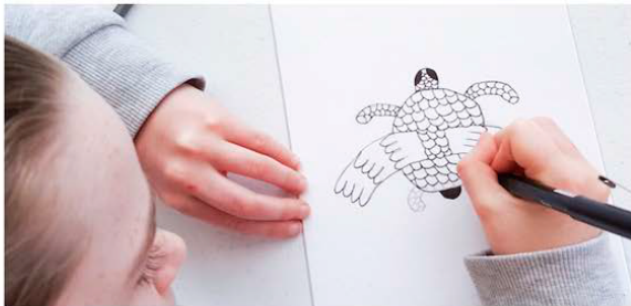

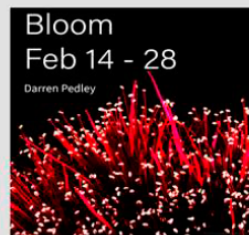
