Our school's Learning Support Team

Our school learning and support team plays a key role in ensuring that the specific needs of students with disability and additional learning and support needs are met. The team consists of our Deputies Mrs Formby and Mrs McKeown, our school counsellor Mrs Trish Stephens, Mrs Martin our Assistant Principal Support Unit and a staff member from each stage. Our Learning and Support teachers also attend meetings which are held fortnightly on Thursday mornings. Our Learning Support staff are Mrs Miller, Mrs Wilson, Mrs Wyard and Mrs Jenkins who work in classrooms assisting students individually or in small groups with literacy, numeracy or English as a second language. If your child is part of these support programs you will receive a letter shortly outlining the area being supported and how you can assist your child at home.

The Learning Support team:

- supports teachers in identifying and responding to the additional learning needs of students
- facilitates and coordinates a whole school approach to improving the learning outcomes of every student
- coordinates planning processes and resourcing for students with disability and additional learning and support needs
- designs and implements the supports required to build teacher capacity so that all students access quality learning
- develops collaborative partnerships with the school, parents and carers, other professionals and the wider school community.

Our School counsellor Mrs Trish Stephens is currently on leave until the last week of term. Mrs Claire Ingrid and Mrs Hilary Wood are replacing Mrs Stephens in her absence.

Red Bus Services School Bus Safety Program

Stephen (Gumnuts) O'Brien, will be visiting us in Weeks 8 and 9 to deliver a bus safety program. The aim of the program is to teach students safe behaviour while on the bus.

The program is run in groups of two or three classes at a time and class teachers remain with their classes during the lessons. The key points of the program include:

- waiting at bus stops
- getting on and off the bus at school and at bus stops
- safe behaviour whilst travelling on the bus
- student code of conduct
- using the School Opal card
- telling the bus driver about problems on the bus
- parent/carers responsibilities (waiting on the correct side of the road)
- evacuation procedure in case of an emergency
- the role of public transport in the community.

National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) **2018**

LETTER TO PARENTS

In May 2018 the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will be completed by students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. NAPLAN has the support of all State and Territory Education Ministers and will assess the literacy and numeracy skills of students across Australian schools.

The results of the tests will provide important information to schools about what each student can do, and will be used to support teaching and learning programs. Parents will receive a report indicating their child's level of achievement. Each student's level of achievement will be reported against the national minimum standard.

Student background information (student name, gender, date of birth, language background and Aboriginality) will be collected as part of the National Assessment Program. This information is treated confidentially and held securely to ensure that every student's right to privacy is maintained.

The NAPLAN tests will be conducted from 15-17 May 2018.

In the numeracy tests students do not require any measuring tools such as rulers or protractors. In Years 7 and 9 there will be one numeracy test with two parts: Part A calculator is allowed and Part B where calculators are not to be used. For the calculator test, the student should use the calculator that they currently use at school.

Friday 18 May – A 'catch-up' day is scheduled for students who missed a test or were absent on a test day. Students may be considered for exemption from the tests if they:

- are newly arrived in Australia (less than one year before the test) and with a language background other than English, **or**
- have significant intellectual disability and/or significant co-existing conditions which severely limit their capacity to participate in the tests.

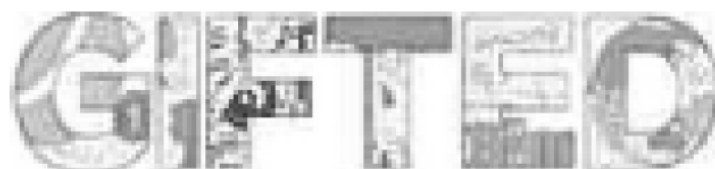
All other students are expected to participate in the tests. Disability adjustments which reflect the student's normal level of support in the classroom may be provided. Large print, braille, coloured paper versions and electronic tests are available to meet the needs of individual students.

Access to disability adjustments or exemption from the tests must be discussed with the school principal and a parent or carer consent form must be signed.

Students may be withdrawn from NAPLAN by their parent or carer. This is a matter for consideration by parents in consultation with the school principal. If you wish to withdraw your child from the tests, a parent or carer consent form must be signed.

Please make an appointment with the principal of the school your child attends if you would like to discuss your child's participation in NAPLAN.

Gifted Awareness Week (GAW) 2018 will be held from the 18th to 24th of March and is centred on the national theme Acceptance: Diversity & Equity."

Next week (March 18-24) is the National Gifted Awareness week in Australia.

Terrigal Public School (TPS) is committed to supporting the needs of Gifted and Talented students within the school from Kindy to Year 6.

The TPS Gifted and Talented committee meets regularly to discuss the needs of students within the school, helps teachers identify Gifted and Talented learners and liaises with the learning support team to provide enrichment opportunities for the GAT students within the school.

Current committee members include Mrs Claudia Cooney (GATS coordinator), teacher representatives from all stages, the school counsellor and 2 parent representatives.

In 2014 a project based learning group was formed to allow students to explore topics of interest and to develop skills in research, public speaking, computer skills and even website development. Topics have included the Pacific Ring of Fire, sharks, pirates, heart disease, learning French and many more. The children really enjoy the collaboration with peers from all grades and also have the opportunity to share the work with their class/class teacher.

We are excited that the project based learning group will continue to evolve in 2018 to include a variety of activities set to ignite and challenge the students' interests and creativity.

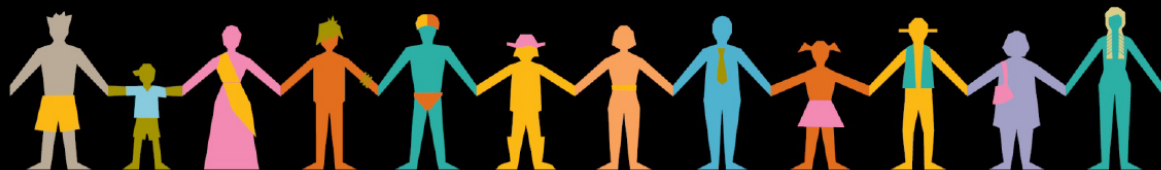

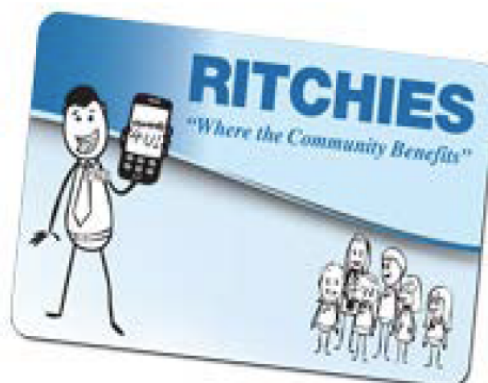

Deconstructed Guacamole of the Imagination

Season: Summer/Autumn

Serves: 30 tastes in the classroom
or 6 serves at home

Fresh from the garden: avocados, coriander, corn kernels (optional) cucumber, garlic, limes, red capsicum (optional), red chilli (optional), red onion, spring onions (optional), tomatoes

Recipe source: Adapted with permission from a recipe by Anna Gare's *Eat In* (Murdoch Books 2013)

This recipe keeps the avocado a little chunky instead of mashing it, and uses red onion and cucumber for a bit of extra crunch. Choose a selection (or all!) of the extra ingredients from the suggestions list to create your own guacamole sensation!

Equipment:

clean tea towel
chopping board
cook's knife
metric measuring scales,
jug and spoons
whisk
2 bowls – 1 medium,
1 large
mixing spoon
serving bowls

Ingredients:

For the guacamole:

1 large cucumber, diced
4 large tomatoes, de-seeded
and diced
1 small red onion, finely chopped
3 large avocados, peeled, de-stoned
and diced
1 large handful of coriander, leaves
and stems roughly chopped

Suggested extras:

1 red capsicum, de-seeded and
finely diced
1 long red chilli, de-seeded and
finely chopped
1 x 200 g can kidney beans
200 g corn kernels, grilled
60 g low-fat sour cream
4 spring onions, finely chopped

For the dressing:

60 ml lime juice
60 ml extra-virgin olive oil
2 garlic cloves, finely chopped
1 tsp sea salt
pinch of white sugar
pinch of freshly ground black pepper,
to taste



What to do:

1. Prepare all of the ingredients based on the instructions in the ingredients list.

To make the dressing:

1. Whisk all of the dressing ingredients together in the medium-sized bowl.

To make the guacamole:

1. Combine all of the guacamole ingredients in the large bowl.
2. Pour over the dressing, gently toss to coat and then serve with your choice of extra ingredients.
