PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Terrigal – A Place of Harmony

On Wednesday we celebrated Harmony Day. Harmony Day is a national day focussed on celebrating the cultural diversity of our great country. Harmony Day is about inclusiveness, respect and belonging for all Australians, regardless of cultural or linguistic background.

At Terrigal students enjoyed a range of fun activities to explore our diversity, build awareness and develop capacity to be accepting of differences. We wore a touch of orange with our uniforms to signify that as a school we come together as a community connected by our commonalities (our uniform) but bringing our cultural heritage (our touch of orange) to brighten our community.

When you look at the statistics you realise how lucky we are to have an amazing country

- nearly half (49 per cent) of Australians were born overseas or have at least one parent who was
- we identify with over 300 ancestries
- since 1945, more than 7.5 million people have migrated to Australia
- 85 per cent of Australians agree multiculturalism has been good for Australia
- apart from English, the most common languages spoken in Australia are Mandarin, Arabic, Cantonese, Vietnamese, Italian, Greek, Tagalog/Filipino, Hindi, Spanish and Punjabi
- more than 70 Indigenous languages are spoken in Australia.

Bus Safety

This week and next week students are undertaking bus safety lessons with Gumnut from Busways. I have some tips below for parents to reinforce the safety messages.

- WAIT on the footpath until the bus has driven away – choose the safest place to cross.
- WATCH until there is no traffic or the traffic has stopped.
- WALK across the road, turning your head both ways to look and listen for traffic.
- Obey reasonable directions from the driver (e.g. where to sit or to remain in the bus)
- Remain in your seat – do not move around the bus unnecessarily
- If standing, remain behind the front passenger seat and keep a secure hand hold at all times
- Keep bags and other items clear of the aisle
- Do not allow any part of your body to protrude out of the bus at any time
- Wait for the bus in a quiet and orderly manner – including at bus interchanges
- Stand away from the roadside until the bus comes to a complete stop
- Allow other passengers to leave the bus before stepping onto the bus in a single line
- Wait until the bus stops before moving to get off the bus at your designated stop
- Wait until the bus leaves the stop and you have clear vision before crossing the road
- Cross the road where and when it's safe to do so, use crossings/traffic lights where available

And some tips for parents:

- Arrange for an adult to accompany your child to and from the bus stop.
- Wait for your child on the same side of the road as the stopping bus.
- Never call for your child to cross the road to meet you.
- Discuss what to do should your child miss the bus or catch the wrong one.

Sydney North Swimming Carnival

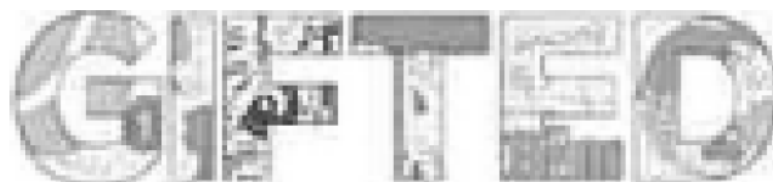
Congratulations to our talented swimmers who will be competing at the Sydney North Swimming Carnival next Thursday, 29 March. We wish them all the best.

The TPS Gifted and Talented committee meets regularly to discuss the needs of students within the school, helps teachers identify Gifted and Talented learners and liaises with the learning support team to provide enrichment opportunities for the GAT students within the school.

Current committee members include Mrs Claudia Cooney (GATS coordinator), teacher representatives from all stages, the school counsellor and 2 parent representatives.

In 2014 a project based learning group was formed to allow students to explore topics of interest and to develop skills in research, public speaking, computer skills and even website development. Topics have included the pacific ring of fire, sharks, pirates, heart disease, learning French and many more. The children really enjoy the collaboration with peers from all grades and also have the opportunity to share the work with their class/class teacher.

Baba Ghanoush (Eggplant Dip)

Season: Summer/Autumn

Makes: 30 tastes in the classroom
or 6 serves at home

Fresh from the garden: eggplants, garlic, lemon, parsley

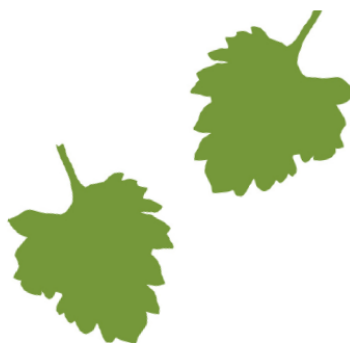
Note: To achieve the distinctive smoky flavour of this dip, grill the eggplant over an open flame. Otherwise, cook on the barbecue or under a grill.

Equipment:

metric measuring jug, cups
and spoons
tea towel
chopping board
cook's knife
juicer
small frying pan
wooden spoon
mortar and pestle
fork
tongs
medium bowl
plastic wrap
colander
paper towels
food processor
spatula
serving bowl

Ingredients:

½ tsp cumin seeds
2 large eggplants
2 cloves garlic, finely chopped
1 small handful of parsley, roughly
chopped
juice of a lemon
1½ tsp salt
¼ cup olive oil
½ cup tahini paste



What to do:

1. Prepare all of the ingredients based on the instructions in the ingredients list.
2. Roast the cumin seeds in a small frying pan over a low heat until aromatic.
3. Grind the toasted seeds in a mortar and pestle and set aside.
4. Prick the eggplants all over with a fork.
5. Hold each eggplant with a sturdy set of tongs and cook over a gas flame for about 10 minutes or until the skin becomes charred.
6. Place the charred eggplants into the medium bowl, cover tightly with plastic wrap and allow to cool, about 10 minutes. This will help blister the skin, making it easier to peel.

7. Peel the skin off the cooled eggplant and run the flesh briefly under running water to remove any leftover skin. Drain and pat excess moisture from the flesh of the eggplant with paper towels.
8. Put the garlic, chopped parsley, toasted ground cumin, lemon juice and salt into the bowl of a food processor and process the ingredients to a coarse blend.
9. Add the eggplant to the food processor and continue to blend until smooth.
10. Drizzle the oil and the tahini slowly into the mix through the funnel of the food processor. Continue to blend, scraping down occasionally, until the dip is thick and creamy.
11. Check seasoning and place in a bowl to serve.
