Congratulations to Kale, Devonte, Mitchell, Sam, Keelan, Jake, Tane, Jayden, and Billy.

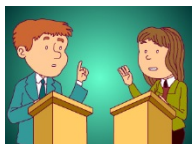

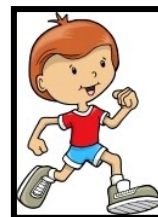

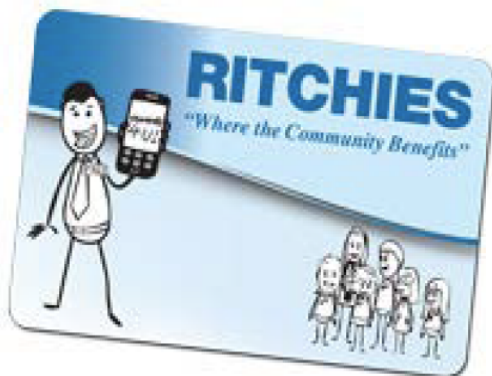

Did you know...

The NSW's new 'Health School Canteen Strategy' is being implemented, with a start date of January 2020.

We are well on our way to implementation, with our current Winter Menu meeting the new criteria of more than 75% everyday foods and less than 25% occasional foods, based on the current strategy's ratings.

Occasional Foods must still be the 'better choices' of these options, and must have a Health Star Rating of 3.5 stars or above.

Some of the occasional items at our canteen include the following;

Yummy Drummies – which have a Health Star Rating of 3.5 stars

Mrs Mac's Lite N Up beef pies – which have a health star rating of 4 stars

Mrs Mac's Lite N Up sausage rolls – which have a Health Star Rating of 4 stars.
