Our Director of Educational Leadership, Chris Bice; the President of the Central Coast AECG, Lesley Armstrong; Kuriwa AECG president Kirsten Booker; representatives of the Department of Education Aboriginal Education team and our P & C Executives were also in attendance. Representatives from Breakers were also at the launch as they had provided a grant to make the video possible.

The video shows that our students are connected, they have aspirations, they are going places and have big ideas. They are modern kids with a focus on the future, but they know that they are only here due to the resilience, the adaptability and the determination of their ancestors.
