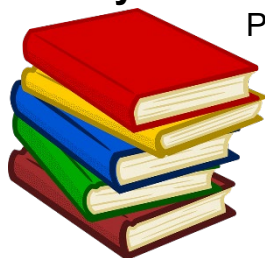

Money Due - *Parent Online Payment (POP) is the school's preferred payment option*

Online Payments is the school's preferred payment option. To access please go onto the school's website and follow the 'Make a Payment' link. This link will direct you to the Westpac Banking site, where you can make payments directly to the school. Please feel free to contact the office, if you need some help or if you want some more information.

Currently we are still taking payments for our voluntary school contributions. Please feel free to contact us if you are not sure if you have made a contribution yet. Schools are funded by the State and Federal Government to provide basic education to students. As a school community we strive to provide additional learning opportunities to students. To assist with the purchase of additional resources, which enhance learning programs, each family is asked to pay a Voluntary School Contribution.

We still have a few families who haven't paid for their children's book packs. Book packs are handed out at the beginning of the year to all students. Each book pack contains items required for each particular grade including the school diary. Book packs are sold at a reduced price which, because of our bulk buying power (and because we don't pay the GST), is approximately half the retail price.

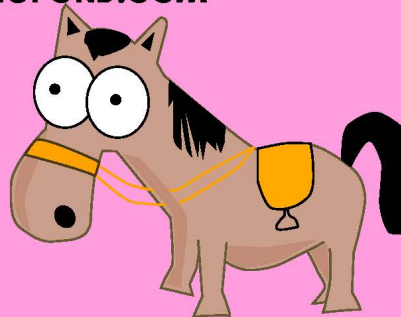

Christmas Tree Sculpture Monday 23rd Dec 10-1pm \$45
In this 3 hour workshop students make a Christmas tree sculpture out of sticks, clay and painted wool, then adorn it with fairy lights. BYO sticks.



Christmas Decorations Tuesday 24th Dec 10-12pm \$30
This fun workshop continues the Christmas theme where students make adorable decorations from pinecones and felt.



Stag Drawing Tuesday 7th Jan 10-12pm \$30
We begin this beautiful stag drawing in pencil on an A3 sheet of watercolour paper. The drawing is then outlined in pen and detailed with dots and swirls.
