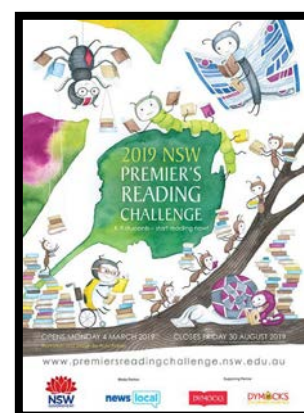

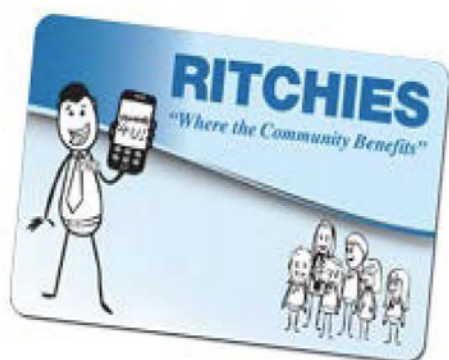


**Next P&C Meeting**

## Dipping Sauce

¾ cup light soy sauce  
1 tbsp sugar  
2 tbsp malt vinegar  
2 tsp sesame oil  
1 red chilli, de-seeded and finely chopped  
1 garlic clove, peeled and finely chopped

### Method

1. Place the soy, sugar and vinegar in a small pot over a low heat and stir until the sugar is dissolved.
2. Mince the garlic and chilli together until it forms a mash.
3. Combine all ingredients in a bowl and mix well.

## Pork Dumplings (adapted from Allrecipes.com)

Wonton wrappers (about 40)  
250g pork mince  
½ tbsp minced fresh ginger  
2 garlic cloves, minced  
2 tbsp thinly sliced green onion  
2 tbsp soy sauce  
1 ½ tbsp sesame oil  
1 egg, beaten  
2 cups finely shredded cabbage

### Method

1. In a large bowl combine the pork, ginger, garlic, green onion, soy sauce, sesame oil,, egg and cabbage. Stir until well mixed.
2. Place 1 teaspoon of filling onto each wonton wrapper.. Moisten edges with water and fold edges over to form a triangle shape.
3. Roll edges slightly to seal.
4. To cook: Steam dumplings in a covered bamboo or metal steamer for about 10 minutes.
5. Serve with dipping sauce.



# Lemongrass

8 stalks of lemongrass

2 knobs of ginger, about 10cm each, peeled and coarsely grated

1 large handful of mint leaves

Juice of 8 lemons

8 tsp loose leaf green tea (or 8 teabags)

1 ½ cups honey

5 L boiling water

Fresh ice and lemon slices, for serving

## Method

1. Cut off and discard the dry root end of each of the lemongrass stalks. Cut off the top half of each stalk and set aside.
2. Cut each lemongrass stalk into four.
3. Whack each piece of lemongrass in a mortar and pestle to crush.
4. Put the lemongrass pieces and the ginger into a large, heat-proof bowl.
5. Add the mint leaves, lemon juice, teabags and honey.
6. Pour the boiling water into the bowl. Cover the bowl with a large plate.
7. Leave the mixture to steep for about 20 minutes.
8. Strain through a colander into a jug or punchbowl to serve. We chilled with ice and added lemon slices to serve.
