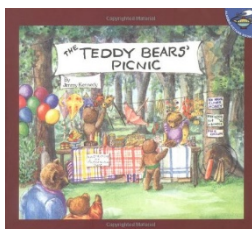

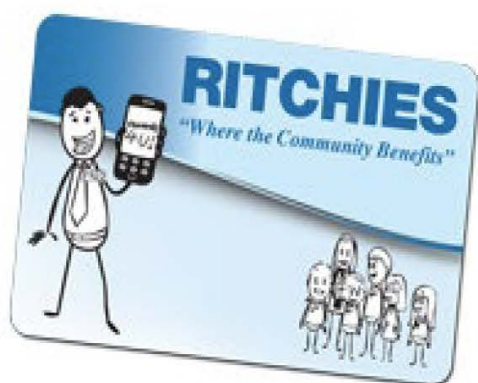



Next P&C Meeting
