To process online payments, just go to the Terrigal PS website <u>www.terrigal-p.schools.nsw.edu.au</u> and follow the 'Make A Payment' link. Other payment options are cash or Eftpos payments through the office. *Please note, we cannot accept payments over the phone anymore.*

You may wonder why we prefer online payments. A report is printed out each morning. From that report we can see exactly which parent paid for what, there is no handling of cash, and refunds are processed a lot quicker.

Did you know you can make multiple payments for the one child in the one transaction? You can also pay for more than one child in one transaction. Just put the second or third child through 'Other'.
