ADMINISTRATION CORNER

Refund Policy

Our school policy on refunds states that if your child is unable to attend due to illness or any other legitimate reason, the school can only refund money paid less funds already committed or spent. For example, in the case of larger excursions, venues and accommodation providers charge us on the numbers we provide in advance of the actual excursion. These venues hire staff, buy food, provide bedding, etc. Based on those numbers, the costs still exist even if a student does not attend. With bus companies we are still charged for a booked seat even if it is not used. For full compensation, parents/caregivers would need to arrange private travel insurance (related to Covid-19 or other unforeseen circumstances) prior to travel. We appreciate your understanding.

Invoices and Payment Options

Stage 3 Camps – total cost for the Aussie Bush Camp comes to \$344. Please deduct the \$100 deposit already paid. Total Cost for the Canberra Excursion comes to \$386. Please deduct the \$100 deposit already paid. *You are more than welcome to pay these excursions off in instalments*.

Reminder invoices for book packs and Stephanie Alexander Kitchen/Garden program have been sent home via your child's class. You are more than welcome to pay off any invoices in instalments, especially if you are paying for more than one student.

- The estimated time required to perform the role is approximately 1 hour per week




