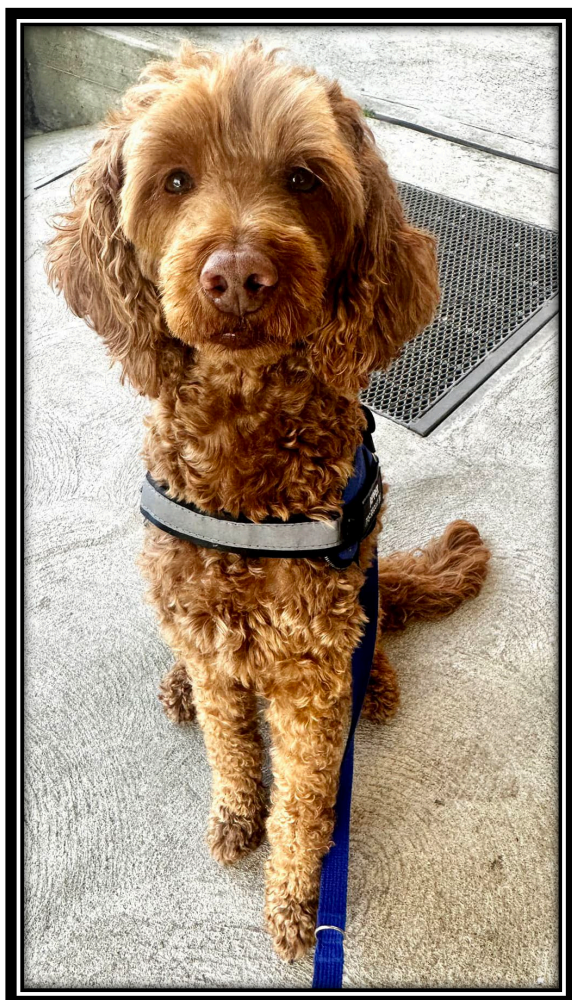

**Compassion** Can I try to understand how the other person feels?

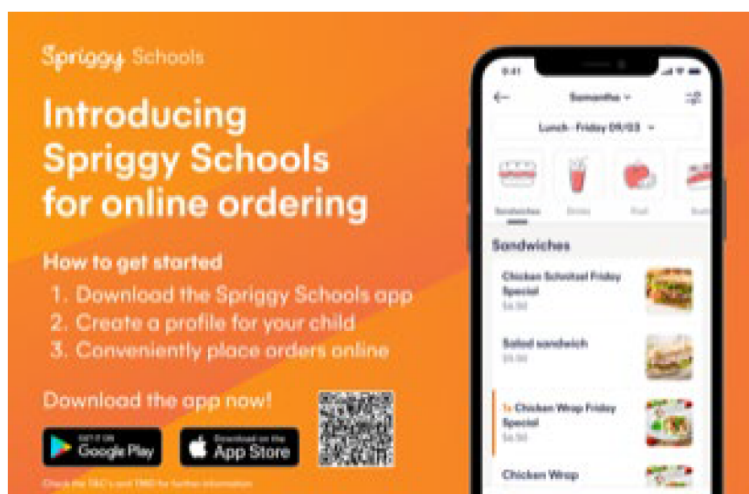
**Empathy** Can I try to see what happened through the other person's point of view?

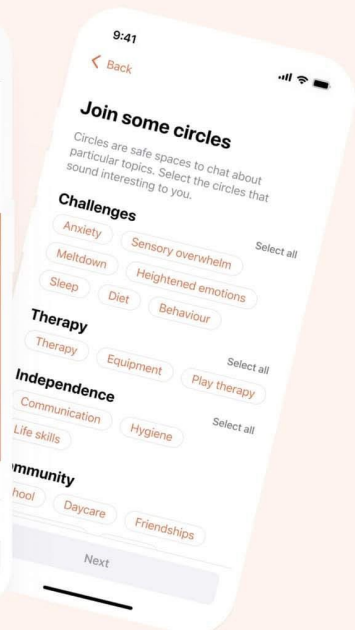
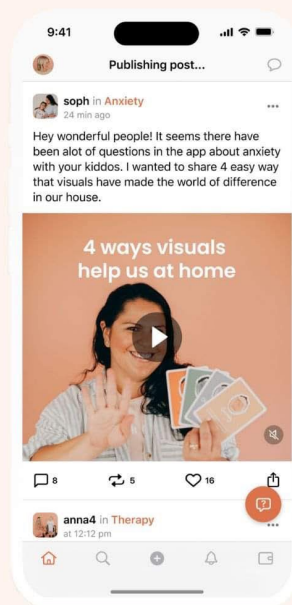

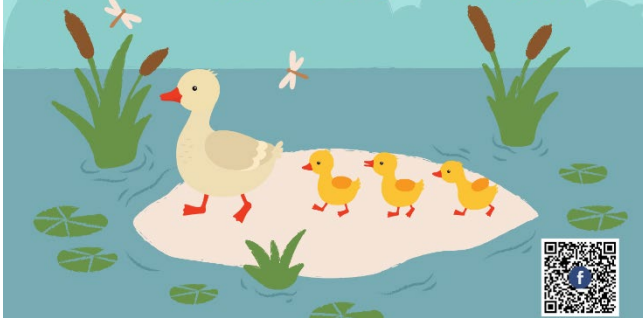
