

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

This year's Year 6 overnight excursion to Canberra has been scheduled for Week 10 of Term 3, from Wednesday 21-Friday 23 September, 2022. To assist with planning, we are distributing important information now and asking families to complete relevant paperwork and begin to make payments.

Excursion Details

The activities undertaken at specific venues visited on the excursion will consolidate content covered in our history unit, 'Australia as a Nation', which will be taught in Term 3. The total cost of the excursion is \$386, which covers the costs of transport, meals (from Wednesday evening), venue entry and accommodation. Supervision at the excursion will be provided by the attending Terrigal Public School staff. All attending staff have training in CPR and emergency care.
